True to its philosophy of concept-based learning, Early Wonders encourages children to explore the real world before forming facts.

Their warm teachers curate rare experiments, role play, and field trips, wherein children learn by doing and observing. A simple ray of light in a dark room becomes a lesson on vision; water under light reveals the colours of a rainbow; and pizza slices help children understand how different shapes come together to



form objects around them.
